


HOW THE SYSTEM WORKS

DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION (DA) THROUGH LOCAL COUNCIL




This is your first opportunity to engage with the decision making process. The notification period will only be open for a few weeks. Contact your council to get access to all the documents that were lodged with the DA. Write your submission outlining your concerns and make sure it's lodged by the due date.

Some councils also give people the opportunity to make their case about a DA at public council meetings. Find out if you have an opportunity to do this by contacting the council when you first lodge your submission.

Once DA and licence is approved there are likely to be conditions imposed on the premise. If these conditions are not being met you can make a complaint.

LIQUOR LICENCE APPLICATION THROUGH ILGA AND OLGR



This is your first opportunity to engage with the decision making process. The notification period will only be open for a few weeks. Write your submission outlining your concerns and make sure it's lodged by the due date.

Even if you have already lodged a submission for the CIS, you can also make a submission at this stage. Contact ILGA to make sure you can review all the documents lodged with the licence application. This includes critiquing whether the applicant has properly addressed concerns raised in the CIS. Write your submission and make sure it's lodged by the due date.
